1807	R and A. Skillern, both died in August 1807.
1809 1818	Ensign H. Logan, died in 1809. Here lie the mortal remains of Mathew Christy M. D. Assistant Surgeon of the Zillah Court of Cuddapah, who departed this life on the 12th April in the year of our Lord 1818 aged 39 years. This tribute of affection is erected by his disconsolate and affectionate widow E. Christy.
1818	Here lies the body of Mathew Christy, the beloved son of Mr. Christy M. D. He died on the 23rd April 1818, 1 year and 8 days.
1819	Sacred to the memory of Agnes Christy, the affectionate daughter of Mathew Christy, She died on the 4th of October 1819, aged 1 year, 2 months and 14 days.
1820	Sacred to the memory of Captain John Power , of the 24th Regiment, Madras Native Infantry, and late paymaster to the Field Force in the Deab, who died at this place on the 17th day of June 1820 aged 35 years. He died as he had lived a sincere Christian, a fond father, an affectionate husband and a sincere friend.
1820	Sacred to the memory of Lieutenant Hamilton Wilson, H. M. 46th Regiment, who departed this life on the 27th of July 1820, on his march to Bellary aged 29 years. This monument is erected by his brother officers as a mark of their esteem and respect.
1822	Charles, the infant son of Captain Charles Poulton and Susana his wife. Born 25th June, died 22nd August 1822, aged 1 month and 28 days.
1823	Ruth Georgiana, daughter of Rev. W. Howell, died on the 13th January 1823
1824	Lieutenant G. F. Boddam, 48th Native Regiment, died on the 25th September 1824, of the spasmodic cholera, aged 26 years.
1825	Sacred to the memory of Henry Agustus Miller, Captain 8th Regiment N. I., who departed this life on the day of May 1825, aged 39 years. This monument is erected by his affectionate widow Charlotte Miller.
1827	Here lieth the body of Edmund Affleck, the infant son of Captain John Gibson. He died on the 9th day of March 1827, aged 1 year, 2 months and 21 days. T. Stewart Esquire, Assistant Surgeon H. C. S. died 7th June 1828, aged 37 years.
1830	This monument is erected by his bereaved widow.
1832	Rev. XIV—13. Erected by the Civil officers of this station as a tribute of affection and esteem to the
	joint memory of Charles Edward Macdonald Esquire of the Madras Civil Service, aged 24 years, a civilian of the fairest promise, who, while attempting in the fearless and conscientious discharge of his duty, to appease by prompt and persuasive measures, the fury of a fanatic rabble of Moormen, assembled on
	the 15th of June 1832, in the Town of Cuddapah, was though completely unarmed, attacked, deserted by all his peons and barbarously murdered, and of Agnes, his wife, who only survived him 21 days, having died on the 7th July 1832, broken hearted, in the 20th year of her age.
1832	"They were lovely in their lives and in death shall not be separated".
1833	7 months, 5 days. Sacred to the memory of C. M. Whish Esquire of the Civil Service, who departed
1838	Sacred to the memory of Ellen, relict of the late Captain Albert Frend , H. M's, 55th Regiment, who departed this life on the 25th day of April 1833 at Cuddapah, when on route from Bellary to Madras, aged 37 years (this melancholy event took place only 2 months and 13 days after the bereavement of her husband.) She has left 9 orphans to lament their irreparable loss. This monument is erected by her affectionate daughter (and son-in-law) Ellen and John Findly Mc. Kenine.
